- School District updates- Kirsten
 - Softball Fields update LOSD is holding a meeting specific to PNA residents; need to talk to neighbors because they changing the current use of the fields; scheduled for April 10th 6pm, Lakeridge Cafeteria, posted on NextDoor by Kirsten.
 - O Palisades School Updates Kirsten met with Dr Heather Beck, Dr Michael Musick and Stuart Ketzler. Palisades will host all 6 pre-K classes for foreseeable future. Will host offices for special education and curriculum enrichment functions. The director of curriculum enrichment, Melissa Griffiths, will act as "principal" of Palisades. Extended care for morning and aftercare for south side schools. Will keep up with the outside of the property; city does the upkeep on the fields and it's a contract with LOSD and city. Music programs will be at LOJ. Kirsten asked for the activities bus from LRJH to make a stop at Palisades, the way that it does for the other 3 elementary schools when it leaves LRJH at 515pm; request is under consideration.
