LAKERIDGE HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT PARKING REGULATIONS 2023-2024

New this Year:

Lakeridge High School will sell two parking permit options this year. The first option is an **Assigned Student Parking Permit**. This option is similar to the last several years with a few added exceptions. To be eligible for an assigned permit, you must be a senior whose name was drawn during the summer parking lottery. The second option is the **General Student Parking Permit**. The holder of this permit will have multiple possible parking options, but no guaranteed parking spot.

The **Assigned Student Parking Permit** features a specifically reserved space. The reserved parking spot will be assigned by number at the time you pick-up the permit. This numbered parking space will be available to you each day until 10:30 am. After 10:30 am, if you have not parked your car in your assigned space or you drove your car off campus for any reason legitimate or otherwise, this space will now be available to anyone with a student parking permit option 1 or option 2. To review, only you can park in your assigned space up to 10:30 am. After that time the space can be used by anyone with an **Assigned Student Parking Permit** or a **General Student Parking Permit**. So, if you did not drive to school on a particular day or you left campus for any reason after 10:30 am, your space would be open to another driver provided they have a valid student parking permit.

Another way to think about the change to the student parking regulations this year, is that after 10:30 am each day, any open space can be used by any student with either parking permit. The administration at Lakeridge High School is hoping that this change will greatly increase the number of cars in our limited parking lot throughout the day and subsequently reduce the number of cars in the neighborhood streets around the school.

Parking Permit Option 2 allows the holder to park in spaces 305 to 327 in the school lot or in any one of the available church lot parking spaces on a first come first served basis at any time during the school day. The holder of this permit may also park in any open student parking space in the Lakeridge High School parking lot after 10:30 am.

In the morning, before school begins, you have three options for parking. The first option is in any of the spaces numbered 305 to 327 in the school lot. The second option is any of open designated student parking space in the church lot across the street. And the third option, if the first two are not available, is to find a legal parking space on the streets immediately adjacent to Lakeridge High School or in the Luscher Farms Parking lot. After 10:30 am, you will have access to any open parking space in the school lot.

Remember - and this is very important - No matter what time it is, you will never have access to a parking space designated for Lakeridge High Staff members or Auction parking spaces.

Q&A:

Question:

What If I leave campus for an 11:30 am Dr's. Appointment, will my parking space be available when I return?

Answer:

Probably not - After 10:30 am, any open parking space will be available to anyone with a permit. However, if it is still open, you certainly may re-park in the space.
