

Traffic Alert: Stafford Road Construction Updates – Weeks of March 17 & March 24

Commuters, take note! Roadwork along Stafford Road, Bergis Road, and Overlook Drive is entering its final stages as part of the improvements surrounding the Lake Oswego Recreation and Aquatics Center. Over the next few weeks, construction crews will be working to enhance the roadway for a smoother, safer, and more accessible ride.

Construction Timeline & Traffic Impacts

Week of March 17:

Pre-paving and removal of old water trenches.

Week of March 24:

Grinding, widening, installation of a new left-turn lane, and final paving. Walkway and ADA-compliant crosswalk enhancements on Bergis Road and Overlook Drive.

What to Expect:

- →Flaggers and lane closures
- **⇒**Extended traffic delays and backups
- →Alternative routes recommended

Work Hours:

March 17–21: 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. (to minimize school traffic disruptions) March 24–28: 9 a.m. – 8 p.m. (extended hours during spring break to expedite completion)

Schedules are weather dependent and subject to change. Final striping and pavement markings will take place later this spring.

We appreciate your patience during these final corridor enhancements! Please note, additional road construction projects with Clackamas County and PGE will be happening simultaneously on Atherton Road and south of the Rosemont Roundabout.
