2. QUORUM: Quorum was achieved. Several guests also joined including Dave Kritler, Nancy Dunis and Rick Cook.

3. COMMITTEE REPORTS

● **Chair Report**

- 1) Bylaw modification will be voted on at the April General meeting. If bylaws are changed, Dave Kritler can be voted on in May to represent area 6. Need $\frac{2}{3}$ of the people who choose to vote, vote in favor of the bylaw change for it to pass.

- 2) April general meeting planned at Park Academy. Carrie asks board members to provide 3 talking points for their slide. Board members will use that slide to speak from at the meeting. Members can only vote for the chair and their neighborhood rep.
- **Vice chair report** -
 - 1) Survey progress is strong. We have had 61 responses to date (March 12). We want responses before the general meeting. As a board, we'll decide how to share results.
 - 2) Waiting on information from the city about how grant application will be handled if the city can pay vendors directly or not.
 - **Yard signs** - Chris got updated signs posted. Signs are new with a skin design so that they can stay up asking people to subscribe to the newsletter when we don't have another message.
 - **Traffic** - Jon asks if someone from the city could speak to issues of speeding on South Shore. He wants to get clarification on who has oversight of South Shore. Chris added that the police department will have a representative speak to the board likely in May.
 - **Treasurer report**- Our account has \$411.58 and we have pending reimbursements of \$75.18 that have not been submitted yet. A question was raised about the amount of reimbursements made in fiscal year and to date there have been \$324.68 reimbursement submitted.
 - **LOSD report** - All schools that received money from the bond will form focus groups. Rebuilt schools will have their kids go to Uplands school while work is underway. Palisades will be remodeled to be earthquake safe. Christ noted that relations with LOSD have improved with Jenny's involvement. Palisades needs 3 classrooms built to accommodate the additional students they will receive as part of the earthquake upgrade plan.
 - **Emergency prep** - Not a lot to report but South Shore Fire Station bond update is encouraging and we'll look for volunteer opportunities to get involved. Chris encouraged everyone to go to the volunteer page. Canvassing is the biggest need. The water distribution test is on pause for now.
 - **Parks** - No new report - any new notes will be added to Basecamp.
 - **Land use** - Ken Allen got final approval from DRC on the Stafford project. Everything with his project is moving forward
 - **Communications and technology** -
 - 1) Newsletters are going out monthly on time and we're getting a lot of hits on traffic updates. Our fresh content helps with Google search. Newsletter had a little bit of a dip in February but no concerns.
 - 2) And we're working on an electronic ballot for the annual meeting.
 - **NextDoor** - Elisa provided a demonstration of how to "fave" the PNA page and how to like or comment on posts. Elisa posts weekly to have a regular drumbeat about what's going on. Chris emphasized the importance of NextDoor to show engagement with PNA.

6. PUBLIC COMMENT - Rick Cook said he has a meeting with CPO and in April/May a candidate form for Clackamas County Commissioners will be available. Discussed issues with traffic accidents and injuries at the roundabout by the high school.
